- **Mandatory New Student Orientation**   
**Mandatory New Student Orientation - Second Year Retention**

Under the mandatory new student orientation, all students in business programs (and other programs as interest increases) would be required to attend a half day event covering the general college orientation, division/program orientation, program advising culminating in registration. Alternative orientation plans will be devised to address the needs of those students who attend strictly online and those who attend the Regional Learning Centers.

The preliminary plan for this activity includes a general college overview followed by break-off sessions by division. Each division will facilitate an orientation specific to division needs. Faculty will be on hand to advise groups of students and individuals with questions. Students will register at a designated location where enrollment services staff will be on hand to walk them through the registration process.
